



1. Objective

The aim of Occupational Health Nurse Certificate program is to increase Occupational Health Standard of practice in Malaysia and to keep abreast with other country practices in the world wide. With the certificate program, nurse will be able to have the special skill to meet the requirement of legislation and industrial needs.

2. Entry Requirement

1. Registered with the Nursing Board of Malaysia or Medical Assistant Board or equivalent.
2. Completed the Occupational Health Nurse Module 1 and Module 2 course.

3. Examination Format

4. Examination Period

Once the candidate satisfies the entry requirement, he/she may complete the examination within two (2) years (24 months) starting from the first examination / paper registered by the candidate.

Candidate who fail, may re-sit the examination within 24 months from the first attempt.

If the candidate fails in the specified period, he/she must re-enrolled as a fresh candidate for the examination.

5. Medium of Instruction

All questions are presented in English and Bahasa Melayu. Candidates may choose to answers in either one language.

6. Certification

A certificate of competency will be awarded when the candidate passed both papers in the specified period (within 24 months from the first attempt) and certificate will be issued by Examination and Certification Division (ECD), NIOSH.
